Gould commented in a 1959 interview with Alan Rich that he had begun to study the Goldberg Variations in about 1950, around the age of 17. It was one of the first works that he had learned "entirely without [his] teacher", and which he had "made up [his] mind about relatively [early]". Few classical recordings have aroused as much fascination as Glenn Gould's 1981 take on Bach's "Goldberg" Variations.
