

Download North Shore Chicago Lakefront Architecture

On today's Chicago skyline the tallest buildings tend to stand out from the rest. But when you drive north on Lake Shore Drive, just before the first westward curve, you'll encounter two towers that helped define Chicago as a leader in Mid-Century Modern architecture: 860-880 Lake Shore Drive. Chicago's Lakefront Trail is an 18-mile paved path to let you run, walk, bike or rollerblade along the beautiful Lake Michigan shore. See what attractions are found along the way and some tips so visitors and locals can enjoy the outdoor space safely.
